

# BYOD - Option 3 - Instructions for first use

1. Plug the **power supply** into the computer, then plug into a **power point** and turn it on.
2. The **battery light** (the middle one on the front edge of the computer should light up. It will be blue if the battery is charged or amber if it is charging).
3. Press the **power button** (above left of keyboard) to start the computer. Wait for Windows to get ready.
4. The computer might restart several times during this process, which can take **up to 15 minutes**.
5. Once complete, the screen will display "eduSTAR", and the time and date.
6. Press **<Enter>** to see the users, and **<Enter>** again to see the login screen.
7. At the bottom left of the login screen are the two accounts - **Administrator** and **Student**. The school technicians have the password to the administrator account, to have access if there are problems with the computer.
8. Click on the **Student** account. You must **change your password** before signing in.
9. Click **<OK>**.
10. There are 3 boxes.
  - a. Leave the top one (Password) **empty**.
  - b. Type your **new password** in the middle box (New Password).
  - c. Type the **same password** again in the bottom box (Confirm Password).
11. Make sure you **do not forget** your password.
12. Click the **right arrow button** next to the bottom box.
13. After a short wait you see the message "**Your password has been changed**".
14. Click on **<OK>**. Wait again while the computer prepares the Student account in Windows. This can take another 5 minutes.
15. When it finishes, your computer is **ready to use**.
